LTD Wins Top Award For Recruitment Campaign

EUGENE, Ore. ---(October 2, 2024)--- Lane Transit District (LTD) earned high honors in the public transportation industry, winning the Grand Award for "Best Marketing and Communications on Workforce Development."

The recruitment campaign already won two first place awards in the 2024 AdWheel competition in February. These awards recognize the marketing and communications efforts of the members of the American Public Transportation Association (APTA).

LTD collaborated with <u>Eugene-based Turell Group</u> to share the stories of current and former employees to support <u>LTD's recruitment and retention effort</u>. "The success of this campaign speaks for itself. LTD is about to start training its next group of bus operators.
